

The Bay of Plenty sits on the Pacific Coast Highway with a 2 and half hour drive from Auckland, 2 hours from the Whitianga in the Coromandel, 45 minutes to Rotorua, 45 minutes through to Hobbiton and 1 hour 15 to the Waikato region. All regions are with in a close proximity and are no further than a 3 hour drive.

Air NZ fly daily from Auckland, Wellington and Christchurch direct.

Did you know that the Bay of Plenty is known as a Coastal Paradise and is where generations of kiwis have spent their holidays for decades, there is 78 miles of white sandy beaches including three of the top beaches in NZ, #1 is Mount Maunganui where you can enjoy a surf, paddle boarding, swimming, fishing, exploring outer Islands and the local marine life. Our other quieter spots along the coast are Waihi Beach, Papamoa Beach and the beautiful Beach of Ohope. All of these beaches are where you will meet the locals.

This area has the highest hours of sunshine in NZ and is highly recommended by visitors late Spring over the Summer and into Autumn which is still sunny and warm. Our winters are mild and still visited by those wanting to enjoy the coast over the quieter times.

Whale Island / Motouhora Island is a birdlife sanctuary for some of our endangered birds including saddlebacks and the Kiwi bird .

Both White Island Tours and KG Kayaks offer trips to this piece of paradise. Each or these trips are different and give you an experience that is very special getting you up close to nature at its best.

White Island Tours offer a half day trip out to this sanctuary on a catamaran built to land safely on the island. You will then be guided around the Island taking in some of the wonderful bird life, and local marine life. As this is a protected Island and with limited access you will also learn about the history and take in some spectacular scenery including a very private hot water beach where your footsteps will be the first for the day. 
